16Jun Los Angeles – Singapore

Depart on your transpacific flight for Singapore on Cathay Pacific Airways via Hong Kong.

17Jun Cross International Dateline

18Jun Arrive Singapore (Meals: L/D)

Arrive into Singapore in the early afternoon. After clearing customs and claiming your luggage, meet your local guide. Transfer to a local restaurant for lunch before arriving at Sentosa Island. Take a brief tour of the island, with the highlight this evening at the Fountain of Wealth, the setting for laser performances. Return to the city after dinner to check into your hotel. Accommodation: Copthorne Orchid Hotel

19Jun Singapore – Malacca (Meals: B/L/D)

A morning city tour of Singapore includes Chinatown, Merlion Park, and Little India, the colorful ethnic quarter of Singapore. After a Hainan Chicken Rice lunch, drive across the Malaysia border as you continue to Malacca. Highlights of Malacca includes St. Paul's Church, A Famosa, Stadthuys, the Statue of St. Francis Xavier, followed by Hang Li Poh's Well and Kuan Yin Temple. Tonight's dinner features Nyonya Cuisine. Accommodation: Holiday Inn Malacca

20Jun Malacca – Genting Highlands (Meals: B/L/D)

Start your morning at a local batik factory to learn the craft of batik painting which involves painting of elaborate and colorful designs onto delicate silk materials. The afternoon is spent taking a ride on the Genting Skyway Gondola up to the beautiful Genting Highlands, over 6,000 feet in elevation. Enjoy an exciting experience at the Genting Casino, being the only legal casino in Malaysia. (smart casual attire required) Accommodation: First World Resort

21Jun Genting Highlands – Kuala Lumpur (Meals: B/L/D)

Explore the Batu Caves, a sacred place for the Hindus in Malaysia, in the morning before continuing on to the capital city of Kuala Lumpur. The 272 steps climb to the top of the cave affords a fantastic panoramic view of the surrounding mountainside. Proceed to a local pewter factory before lunch. Arrive into the city in the afternoon, visiting the KL Tower and Petronas Twin Tower. Stops will be made at the National Monument and National Museum before this evening's dinner that includes a Cultural show. Accommodation: Royale Chulan

22Jun Kuala Lumpur – Hong Kong (Meals: B)

The morning is left free for you to enjoy a relaxing breakfast at the hotel and do some last minute souvenir shopping before transferring to the airport for your departure flight to Hong Kong. Upon arriving into Hong Kong, you will be met by the local guide. Transfer to the hotel to check in. Accommodation: Empire Kowloon or similar

23Jun Hong Kong

Depart for the island of Hong Kong in the morning, first arriving at the Victoria Peak Tram. The tram slowly makes its way up the hill, revealing a fantastic view of Hong Kong harbor below. Continue on to Repulse Bay, one of the most spectacular bays in the region. The soft golden sand set against the clear blue water makes it the ideal beach to visit

for locals and visitors alike. Get a glimpse into the life of traditional boat-dwellers at Aberdeen fishing village. To this day, hundreds of junks, sampans and old-fashioned boats still serve as floating homes for thousands of people. The place to find that perfect souvenir is at Stanley Market where numerous bargains are to be found. Return to your hotel in the early afternoon. The rest of the day is left for you to stroll along the shopping area of Tsimshatsui.

24Jun Hong Kong – Macau – Hong Kong (Meals: L)

Depart in the morning to board the Hydrofoil for a quick cross across the ocean to the island of Macau. Under Portuguese sovereignty for four centuries until 1999, the small island of Macau has many UNESCO World Heritage monuments, the most famous is the façade of St. Paul's Church. A visit to Macau reveals the Portuguese influences in the islands architecture, customs, and cuisine. Revel at the modern side of Macau, with towering casinos that rival that of Las Vegas. Stroll through the public square, filled with curio shops, bakeries, and antique shops. Enjoy lunch on the island before returning to Hong Kong by hydrofoil. The rest of the evening is free for you to explore this shopper's & eater's delight. (L)

25 Jun Hong Kong – Hanoi (Meals: L/D)

Rise and shine early this morning for your flight to Hanoi, the capital of Vietnam. Arrive into Hanoi in the morning. After claiming your luggage and clearing customs, you will be met by a Signature Travel & Tours Program Manager. Transfer to the hotel to check in. Enjoy some time to relax before an afternoon tour around the Old Quarters by 'cyclo.' This evening, meet your fellow travelers at the welcome dinner featuring the local favorite, beef noodle soup also known as 'pho.' (D) Accommodation: Hanoi D'Maison

26Jun Hanoi – Halong Bay (Meals: B/L/D)

Travel to the northern city of Halong in the early morning to board the Indochina Sails ship. The boat will set sail along Halong Bay at noon, where you will enjoy a delicious lunch on board docking at Bat Cave. You have the option to visit a local fishing village by tender boat or go on a guided kayak tour of the cave. The afternoon shore excursion takes you to Soi Sim beach. Arrive at the boat's docking area at Luon Bo in the early evening. Enjoy a sundowner on deck before dinner. (B/L/D) Accommodation: Indo China Sails Junk

27Jun Halong Bay – Hanoi (Meals: B/L/D)

An early morning session of Tai Chi is offered on deck should you wish to do some stretching or you can watch the sun rise over the limestone cliffs. Enjoy brunch on board before returning to Hanoi by car. An afternoon tour of Hanoi begins at the One Pillar Pagoda, constructed by Emperor Ly Thai Tong, to resemble a lotus blossom. The Temple of Literature was founded in 1070 by Emperor Ly Thanh Tong and dedicated to Confucius. Vietnam's first university was also established here to educate the sons of mandarins. View the former residence of Ho Chi Minh, a stilt house constructed in the style of Vietnam's ethnic minority groups. Tonight's dinner features grilled fish.

Transfer to the airport after breakfast for your departure flight home.
